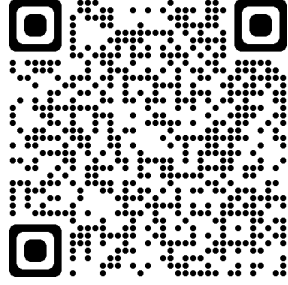

Town of Greenwich Parks and Recreation—Anti-discrimination Policy

The Town complies with all applicable federal and state laws regarding non-discrimination, equal opportunity, affirmative action, and providing reasonable accommodations for persons with disabilities.
