**WHEREAS**, while serving on the Board of Health as Chairman, Dr. Ailleo, among numerous other accomplishments, guided the Department during the West Nile Virus (WNV) crisis and endorsed the Greenwich Emergency Medical Service (GEMS) contract in providing advanced life support services to the Greenwich community; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Ailleo supported the Department Laboratory and endorsed the Tick and Radon testing programs;
