- No. 1 PLZE20180043 **257 BRUCE PARK AVENUE, (LOT 1) GREENWICH.** Appeal of 257 Bruce Park Avenue, LLC. for variances of required parking and front yard setback to permit the construction of a new dwelling on a lot located in the R-6 zone.
- No. 2 PLZE20180044 **257 BRUCE PARK AVENUE, (LOT 2) GREENWICH.** Appeal of 257 Bruce Park Avenue, LLC. for a variance of required gravel or paved way within an access way to permit the construction of a new dwelling on a proposed lot located in the R-6 zone.
- No. 3 PLZE20180051 **52 JOHN STREET, GREENWICH.** Appeal of Winnetka Partners, LLC for a variance of required paved or gravel way within an access-way to permit a paved way outside the access way of a rear lot located in the RA-4 zone.
