1. Call to order.

The meeting was called to order at 9:36 a.m.

a. Attendance:

- c. Select-person Janet Stone McGuigan – Present

2. Executive Session – Discussion of strategy regarding pending litigation - Birdies Restaurant II, LLC v. Town of Greenwich; relocation assistance lien on behalf of the Department of Human Services.

Upon a motion by Ms. Rabin and a second by Ms. Stone McGuigan, the Board voted unanimously to enter Executive Session at 9:36 a.m.

Also in attendance were Board Secretary Barbara Heins, Town Attorney Barbara Schellenberg, Assistant Town Attorney Aamina Ahmad, Human Services Commissioner Demetria Nelson, Human Services Director of Case Management Scott Harvey and Parks & Recreation Director Joe Siciliano.

At 9:40 a.m., Mr. Camillo recused himself for the discussion about the relocation assistance lien because he knows Mr. Steven Chila, the subject of the lien.

Upon a motion by Ms. Rabin and a second by Ms. Stone McGuigan, the Board voted unanimously to leave the Executive Session at 10:04 a.m.

Upon a motion by Ms. Rabin and a second by Ms. Stone McGuigan, the Board voted 2-0-1 to place a relocation lien in the amount of \$4,000 on behalf of the Department of Human Services on property at 158 Byram Road that is owned by Mr. Steven Chila.
