Treasurers report – Bill Grep said there is about \$47,000 in the operations account.

Coordinators report – Steve reported that the boat is at Beacon Point for maintenance and repairs – Rick said that he would have no problem keeping the boat at Beacon Point for the winter. Steve mentioned that the marina will just need to be called ahead of time when using the boat so any ice can be cleared.

UCONN Testing – The toxin testing came back acceptable and the recreational shellfish beds were opened prior to Christmas.

Single cage Greenwich Homeowners project – Need to finalize instructions and information for homeowners.

GCD school cage – GCDS visited Lucas Point and checked the oyster cage project. Then new teacher was with them as well as 5 of the new class that will be taking over the project

Lucas Point – This project is back in discussion again and hopefully will move forward with it this year

Stellamar – Roger said that Steve would like to continue the use of the Greenwich bed through August of this year.

54 Byram Drive Dock application – Roger said that the expert witness will send a copy of the report once completed. Rick Kral brought up the need to find out what the riparian rights are for this location. Roger said it was brought up by the Harbor Management Commission, but he did not know what if anything they found out. Discussion ensued
