



Pursuant to the foregoing notice a Representative Town Meeting of the Town of Greenwich was held in the Moderator's Hall on Monday, October 27, 2014 at 8:00 P.M. (D.S.T.).

The meeting was called to order by the Moderator Thomas J. Byrne.

The members pledged allegiance to the flag, led by Central Middle School 8th grader Grace Fahey with help of her brother TJ, daughter of Susan D. Fahey of District 11.

The Moderator announced that as all members had received a copy of the call for the Meeting, the reading of the call would be omitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Representative Town Meeting approves any terms of such agreement which may be in conflict with the Town Charter, special act, ordinance, rule or regulation adopted by the municipal employer or its agents of the Town.

In addition thereto the Representative Town Meeting approves the funds necessary to implement the terms of the Town-Silver Shield Association collective bargaining agreement covering the period FY 15/16 and FY 16/17 subject to the budgetary process as prescribed in the Town Charter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Representative Town Meeting approves any terms of such agreement which may be in conflict with the Town Charter, special act, ordinance, rule or regulation adopted by the municipal employer or its agents of the Town.
