The Greenwich Police Department is accepting applications for the Fall 2019 Citizen's Police Academy Class. The 8 week session will commence on Wednesday, September 18, 2019 and meet once a week from 6:30 - 9:00 p.m. on Wednesdays\*. Graduation will be held on Wednesday, November 6, 2019.

The Citizen's Police Academy is a program that provides Greenwich residents with a first hand overview of the law enforcement and community related functions of the Greenwich Police Department.

Instructors for the program will be highly trained and experienced Greenwich Police Officers. There is no fee for the eight week program. Any Greenwich resident, or person employed in Greenwich, **18** years of age or older, may apply.\*\* Seating will be limited to 40 persons.

**Due to the high demand of this class, qualified applicants will be subject to a lottery drawing to determine the class roster.**

\* One Saturday Session is scheduled for Saturday, October 19, 2019 (9:00am to 12:00pm) and one Monday Session, October 21, 2019. Hours are subject to change.

\*\*Applicants must be Greenwich residents or employed in Greenwich and should attempt to attend each class of instruction.
