

## Tipping Fee vs Pay As You Throw (PAYT)

<b>Comparison of Tipping Fee and PAYT Options</b>		
	<i><b>Tipping Fee for All Users</b></i>	<i><b>PAYT for All Users</b></i>
Requires legislative process to implement (ordinance, ability to assess fee)?	Yes	Yes
Requires changes to Holly Hill infrastructure to implement?	Yes, need some system to monitor passenger vehicles	No
Encourages waste minimization efforts?	No	Yes
Creates new revenue source?	Yes	Yes
Reduces annual operating expenses?	No	Yes
Links cost of disposal volume directly to amount disposed?	No	Yes
Encourages food scrap recycling (aka composting)?	No	Yes, helps minimize waste stream
Requires additional Town staff?	Possibly, depending on approach to manage passenger vehicles delivering waste	No
Requires Town staff to handle financial transactions (credit card) for commercial haulers	Yes – small amount of time added to each MSW load handled on scale to process payment	No
Requires Town staff to handle financial transactions for passenger vehicles (residents)?	Yes – through permit system, pay per load, pay per card, etc.	No
Causes illegal dumping?	Unlikely	Unlikely
May cause increased traffic at Holly Hill?	Possible – but people may get tired of traffic and use private hauler	Possible, but people may get tired of traffic and will have less to dispose of/come less frequently
Do hauling companies remain private and can residents still use who they want?	Yes	Yes
