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Dear Greenwich Planning and Zoning Department and Commission, Greenwich BET, Greenwich BoE, and Fred Camillo, First Selectman,

Thank you for your service to Greenwich especially in these extraordinary times. We were invited to comment on the upcoming pre-application meeting for Phase 1. We realize that Phase 2 and a complete access road was not funded by the BOE at this time and that budgets for all priorities will be tighter than ever.

We support the necessary expenditures to update GHS Cardinal Stadium – **IF** smart and responsible development is done. We believe that the Town should not do Phase 1 without a commitment to a 2nd form of egress being built in the near future that would help conform the project to POCD and P and Z guiding principles. Doing phase 1 without doing the full access road as a second phase gives us concern that, in this environment, the road will never be built. We support investing in GHS and Cardinal Stadium and giving our students an up-to-date, ADA compliant, top notch high school and athletic facility. Greenwich should have a top high school that draws new families to our wonderful town. **Let's do this project smartly by committing to finishing the full access road as a separately timed but required action in approving Phase I. Installing a second form of egress would, in a single step, ameliorate the 50-year history of traffic, parking, and safety problems of this high school and neighborhood:**

1.Set the Proper Foundation and Infrastructure for a Large Campus Development

While the BoE did not green light Phase 2, we would urge all decision makers to do the project correctly and cost effectively by committing to a full access road. Setting the right infrastructure such as a proper flow and more parking is vitally important before you add the bells and whistles of changing rooms, fancy lights, and announcement booths.

2.Adequate Parking, Traffic Flow, and Safety for a New Expanded Cardinal Stadium

If the Town wants to put more facilities and capacity at Cardinal Stadium, and the FAR and Parking is already challenged, please put in the full road / egress to facilitate a safe flow and more parking and relieve the impact on our neighborhood.

3.Safety is your First and Paramount Fiduciary Responsibility

It is public knowledge about the safety concerns at GHS. Not having a second form of egress for one of the state's largest High Schools is unacceptable. **The PTA, The Police, parents and other town officials have asked for a 2nd form of egress.** Short sightedness in planning and execution should not be repeated. Inviting large crowds to a fancy new facility would be a tragedy with only one form of egress if an emergency struck and it would be costly if lawsuits ensued.

4.POCD/P and Z Principles

Please, as you review Phase 1 – consider the 2 current studies and the many previous traffic studies that have shown that the GHS Campus area is one of the top 5 most congested and

troubled areas (even without the increased traffic on Fairfield and Hillside with GCDS's new athletic complex).

5. Cost Savings – Simultaneous Remediation and Construction of Stadium & Road

Consider the cost and planning benefits if construction and remediation could be done at the same time before prices increase, especially post pandemic.

Now more than ever any infrastructure projects need to be methodically planned and executed to maximize resource utilization. Ensuring that an access road will be built simultaneously as a second phase requirement for Phase 1 approval gives Greenwich the best usage and the least long-term expenditure of time and money. Moreover, it will help safety and compliance to P and Z considerations of traffic and parking, and respects the constituency of the entire school and surrounding neighborhoods.

I understand there is a meeting tonight to preliminarily review the plans consisting of two phases the first of which is to renovate the stadium, bleachers, build adjacent spaces for toilets and team rooms as well as improvements to the site to provide better access. Dear Greenwich Planning and Zoning Department & Commission, Greenwich BET, Greenwich BoE, and First Selectman Camillo,

We are writing in support of the Phase 2 update to GHS Cardinal Stadium with the inclusion of a 2nd form of egress conforming the project to POCD and P & Z guiding principles.

The full access road is a critical and much needed solution to problems in the Hillside Road area that far exceed the inadequacy of the current GHS stadium. Safety is our #1 concern. In addition, I imagine there could be significant cost savings for the Town in carrying out the road project simultaneously with the overall stadium project, rather than in piecemeal fashion.

As to timing, while we realize Greenwich Public Schools have not yet determined if school will resume this calendar year (and obviously in-school learning takes priority over construction timing), it would seem optimal, should GHS end up being closed until August, to fast track the entirety of the project through approvals to allow as much construction as possible to advance while students are out. Last year, we were baffled as to why the sidewalk project, begun at the end of June, stopped for a 4-5 week hiatus in July, only to resume again as school was returning. This caused great disruption to traffic flow and danger to pedestrians, most of whom are students.
