THE FIRST SELECTMAN, IN COLLABORATION WITH HIS EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TASK FORCE ANNOUNCES THE MANAGED RE-OPENING OF BYRAM PARK

### ACCESS TO BYRAM PARK IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING RULES:

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING RULES CAREFULLY. THEY ARE INTENDED TO ENSURE YOUR HEALTH AND SAFETY, AND THAT OF FELLOW PARKGOERS. ANYONE CAUGHT IN VIOLATION WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A LOSS OF PARK PRIVILEGES.

1. SOCIAL DISTANCING OF AT LEAST 6 FEET MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES WHEN ON THE PROPERTY INCLUDING IN THE PARKING LOT. YOU MUST IMMEDIATELY LEAVE THE PROPERTY AFTER YOUR VISIT AND NOT CONGREGATE IN THE PARKING LOT.
2. EVERYONE MUST HAVE A CLOTH FACE COVERING OR HIGHER LEVEL OF PROTECTION WHENEVER CLOSE CONTACT IS UNAVOIDABLE WHILE USING THE PARK FACILITIES.
3. DRIVERS, BIKERS, WALKERS AND JOGGERS AND BOATERS MUST SHOW THEIR 2019 / 2020 PARK PASS OR DRIVERS LICENSE / STATE ISSUED ID WITH GREENWICH ADDRESS. **SINGLE ENTRY AND PARKING PASSES WILL NOT BE SOLD UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.**
4. VEHICLES MUST PARK IN THE DESIGNATED PARKING SPACES. FOR THE PURPOSE OF WALKING, FOLLOW THE ARROWS IN A CLOCKWISE DIRECTION.
5. **NO CHAIRS, COOKOUTS, PICNICS, SWIMMING OR SUN BATHING.** THE BEACH AREA, POOL, PLAYGROUNDS, PAVILLIONS, TENNIS COURTS AND FIELDS WILL **REMAIN CLOSED.**
6. TRASH; CARRY IN, CARRY OUT.
7. MAX CAPACITY= 150 VEHICLES. TO AVOID OVERCROWDING AND TO ALLOW OTHERS TO ENJOY THE PARK, **PLEASE LIMIT YOUR VISIT TO 1 HOUR OR LESS.**
8. THE **CONCESSION** STAND WILL OPEN BEGINNING MAY 22, 2020, WEATHER PERMITTING. MENU IS LIMITED—**ALL SOCIAL DISTANCING RULES APPLY.**
9. THE GREENWICH POLICE DEPARTMENT AND PARK MONITORS WILL BE MONITORING FOR RULE COMPLIANCE.

Although we will continue to make every effort to provide a healthy environment, **PLEASE MAKE RESPONSIBLE DECISIONS, BASED ON YOUR PERSONAL RISK PROFILE, ON WHETHER TO EXPOSE YOURSELF TO OTHERS BY VISITING THE PARK.**

We will continue to provide outdoor recreation opportunities during this heightened alert period as long as **everyone obeys the above safety practices.** We will continue to monitor the recommendations by the CDC, local, state and national authorities and keep you updated on changes. **IF YOU, A FAMILY MEMBER OR SOMEONE YOU HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH HAS RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS, PARTICULARLY A FEVER, DO NOT VISIT THE PARK.**
