ANNOUNCES THE MANAGED UPDATE OF BYRAM PARK

ACCESS TO BYRAM PARK ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING RULES:

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING RULES CAREFULLY. THEY ARE INTENDED TO ENSURE YOUR HEALTH AND SAFETY, AND THAT OF FELLOW PARKGOERS. ANYONE CAUGHT IN VIOLATION WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A LOSS OF PARK / POOL PRIVILEGES.

1. SOCIAL DISTANCING OF AT LEAST 6 FEET MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES WHEN ON THE PROPERTY INCLUDING IN THE PARKING LOT.
2. EVERYONE MUST HAVE A CLOTH FACE COVERING OR HIGHER LEVEL OF PROTECTION WHENEVER CLOSE CONTACT IS UNAVOIDABLE WHILE USING THE PARK FACILITIES.
3. EFFECTIVE JULY 6, RENEWED 2020 PARK PASSES WILL BE **REQUIRED** FOR ALL RESIDENTS. THE SALE OF SINGLE ENTRY PARK PASSES AND PARKING PASSES WILL BEGIN ON JULY 16 IN **LIMITED DAILY QUANTITIES**. CLICK [HERE](#) FOR FURTHER TICKET SALES INFORMATION.
4. THE CLAMBAKE AREA IS **OPEN**. RESERVATIONS ARE **REQUIRED**. THERE IS A **MAXIMUM OF 100 PARTICIPANTS**.
5. THE BEACH AREA IS OPEN, **SOCIAL DISTANCING RULES APPLY**. IN ADDITION, OTHER RULES SPECIFIC TO EACH LOCATION WILL BE POSTED AND ENFORCED. SWIMMING IS **ONLY** PERMITTED IN THE DESIGNATED SWIM AREA.
6. MAX CAPACITY= 150 VEHICLES. TO AVOID OVERCROWDING AND TO ALLOW OTHERS TO ENJOY THE PARK, THERE IS **A SUGGESTED VISIT TIME OF 2 HOURS**.
7. THE **CONCESSION** STAND IS OPEN, WEATHER PERMITTING. MENU IS LIMITED—ALL SOCIAL DISTANCING RULES APPLY.

POOL: Closed for the season
