Acceptable proofs of residency: driver's license, utility bill (cable, electric, gas, water), tax bill (property tax), residential lease.

Residential Parking Program Rules and Regulations

The Town of Greenwich has designated various streets for the Residential Parking Program which restricts parking on those residential streets to residents of that street. Residents that reside in the designated residential streets who wish to utilize on-street parking must obtain a Residential Parking Permit. Parking permits must be renewed every two years but Residential Parking Permit applications are accepted on a continuous basis.

The Residential Parking Permit Rules and Regulations are as follows:

Residential Parking Permit holders must obey all other parking rules and regulations. Residents are subject to all other posted regulations in the residential zone including no parking for more than 24 hours (*see ordinance below*), no parking zones, fire hydrant, and street sweeping and/or snow removal restrictions.

**The fine for parking in a Residential Parking Zone without the appropriate zone decal is:
\$ 55; \$ 110 after 15 days; and \$ 165 after 30 days.**

There is a **twenty-four (24) hour parking restriction** for all vehicles parked on municipal property in the Town of Greenwich. Section 14-17.1 of the Greenwich Town Code states “no vehicle shall be parked upon any portion of any street or upon any portion of the entire width between the boundary lines of any publicly maintained property when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel or upon any property owned or leased to the Town, for a period of time longer than twenty-four (24) consecutive hours. Each period of time of one (1) hour in excess of the period of twenty-four (24) hours shall constitute a separate and additional offense.”
