ANNOUNCES THE MANAGED RE-OPENING OF ISLAND BEACH AND FERRY SERVICE.

## ACCESS TO ISLAND BEACH AND FERRY SERVICE ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING RULES:

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING RULES CAREFULLY. THEY ARE INTENDED TO ENSURE YOUR HEALTH AND SAFETY, AND THAT OF FELLOW ISLAND VISITORS. ANYONE CAUGHT IN VIOLATION WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A LOSS OF FERRY PRIVILEGES FOR THE SEASON.

1. SOCIAL DISTANCING OF AT LEAST 6 FEET MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES WHEN ON THE PROPERTY INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE FERRY DOCK, FERRY, ISLAND BEACH AND THE PARKING LOT.
2. EVERYONE MUST HAVE A CLOTH FACE COVERING OR HIGHER LEVEL OF PROTECTION WHENEVER CLOSE CONTACT IS UNAVOIDABLE WHILE USING THE FERRY AND ISLAND FACILITIES.
3. FERRY PASSENGERS MUST SHOW THEIR 2019 / 2020 PARK PASS OR DRIVERS LICENSE / STATE ISSUED ID WITH GREENWICH ADDRESS. EFFECTIVE JULY 6, RENEWED 2020 PARK PASSES WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ALL RESIDENTS.
4. FERRY PASSENGERS MUST FOLLOW ONSITE POSTED INSTRUCTIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS FROM BOAT CREW REGARDING BOARDING AND DISEMBARKING THE VESSEL.
5. FERRIES WILL RUN AT A REDUCED CAPACITY. PLEASE CONSIDER THE REDUCED CAPACITY WHEN PLANNING YOUR RETURN TRIP.
6. OUTBOUND TRIPS TO ISLAND BEACH MAY BE MODIFIED UPON REACHING MAX CAPACITY.
7. CONCESSIONS, PLAYGROUNDS, SHOWERS AND WATER FOUNTAINS REMAIN CLOSED.
8. SWIMMING IS ONLY PERMITTED IN THE DESIGNATED AREAS.
9. THE GREENWICH POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TOWN PERSONNEL WILL BE MONITORING FOR RULE COMPLIANCE.

Although we will continue to make every effort to provide a healthy environment, **PLEASE MAKE RESPONSIBLE DECISIONS, BASED ON YOUR PERSONAL RISK PROFILE, ON WHETHER TO EXPOSE YOURSELF TO OTHERS.**

We will continue to provide access to our customers during this heightened alert period as long as **everyone obeys the above safety practices**. We will continue to monitor the recommendations by the CDC, local, state and national authorities and keep you updated on changes. **IF YOU, A FAMILY MEMBER OR SOMEONE YOU HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH HAS RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS, PARTICULARLY A FEVER, DO NOT VISIT TOWN FACILITIES.**
