How to Apply for a Boat Mooring in Greenwich

If you would like a mooring in one of the Greenwich Harbors, you will need to complete a Greenwich Harbor Management Commission (GHMC) application.

If you are a member of Belle Haven Club, Indian Harbor Yacht Club, Riverside Yacht Club, or The Rocky Point Club, please apply directly through your yacht club since they are part of a managed mooring field.

If you are a new mooring applicant, please fill out an "new" application and submit it to the GHMC. You will want to identify your preferred mooring location and the harbormaster will try to accommodate your request.

A list of approved mooring vendors that can assist with servicing and inspecting your mooring can be found on the Mooring Permit Application page.

Please be sure to attach all three (3) documents to your application:

1. Copy of your boat registration or a copy of your USCG vessel documentation;
2. Copy of your current \$300,000 liability insurance declaration that includes your policy number and expiration date. (NOTE: If you are a yacht club member you may also need to comply with their requirements);
3. Check for \$75 payable to THE TOWN OF GREENWICH.

Once the application is complete and signed, please mail it along with your registration, insurance information, and check to:

Upon receipt of the required documents, we will issue you a mooring sticker to attach to your mooring ball.
