



Town of Greenwich Department of Parks and Recreation Greenwich Dog Park

Located at Grass Island off Shore Road the Greenwich Dog Park is $\frac{3}{4}$ acre fenced area for canine off-leash recreation. The dog park adjoins the waste water treatment plant at Grass Island and includes running water, benches, trash barrels, and cleanup station for dog waste.

Dog Park Rules

- ✓ Dog park hours of operation will be sunrise to sunset.
- ✓ All dogs must wear a valid license tag, and a valid rabies tag.
- ✓ Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and upon leaving the dog park.
- ✓ Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited.
- ✓ Dogs in heat are prohibited.
- ✓ No smoking or food of any kind (human or pet) allowed in the dog park.
- ✓ Owners are required to pick up and properly dispose of their dog's waste.
- ✓ Owners are responsible for the actions and behavior of their dogs.
- ✓ Aggressive dogs are not permitted on the premises.
- ✓ Dogs showing signs of aggression must be leashed and immediately removed from the dog park.
- ✓ Owners must remain in the fenced area with their dog while the dog is off leash.
- ✓ Owners must carry a leash at all times while in the dog park.
- ✓ Children 10 years and under are not permitted inside the fenced area.
- ✓ All children over 10 years and under 16 years must be closely supervised.
- ✓ Limit two dogs per person per visit. **NO COMMERCIAL DOG WALKERS**
- ✓ It is recommended that no more than 20 dogs be within the dog park at one time.
