Police Academy recruits receive 6 weeks of comprehensive instruction with the Greenwich Police Department. Recruits will also be eligible to participate in a ride-along program with a Police Officer and have the opportunity to participate in a marine instruction and ride along on Long Island Sound with the GPD Marine Patrol at a later date.

The Greenwich Police Department is accepting applications for the Spring 2021 Citizen's Police Academy Class. The 6-week session will commence on Wednesday, May 12th and meet once a week from 6:30 - 8:00 p.m. (Wednesdays). Graduation will be held on Wednesday, June 16th, 2021.

The Citizen's Police Academy is a program that provides Greenwich residents with a first hand overview of the law enforcement and community related functions of the Greenwich Police Department.

Instructors for the program will be highly trained and experienced Greenwich Police Officers. There is no fee for the six-week program. Any Greenwich resident, or person employed in Greenwich, **18 years of age or older**, may apply.**

Seating will be limited to 15 persons.

Due to limited capacity, qualified applicants will be subject to a lottery drawing to determine the class roster.

**Applicants must be Greenwich residents or employed in Greenwich and should attempt to attend each class of instruction.
