

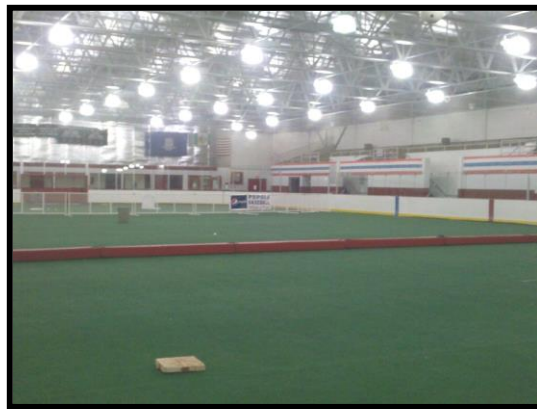


# Dorothy Hamill Indoor Turf

The turf field can be used for Lacrosse, Soccer, Whiffle Ball, Flag Football, T-ball, etc.

Turf Rental Rate is  
\$65 per hour from May 1- June 30  
\$50 per hour after July 1

\*There will be a \$25 fee for any returned checks

## **DHSR INDOOR TURF RULES**

- No Food, Drink or Gum on Turf or in The Players Boxes
- No Metal Cleats or High Heeled Shoes Permitted On Turf
- The Use of Tobacco and Alcohol Products Is Strictly Prohibited
- Pets are not allowed in the building
- Access to Turf Is Limited to Players and Coaches **ONLY**
- The turf must be cleared of all equipment and left clean following your rental
- Liability Insurance plus an endorsement letter listing the Town of Greenwich as additionally insured may be required

## **COVID-19 PROGRAM ADJUSTMENTS**

- The wearing of face masks will be required of all instructors and participants in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order
- All participants should bring their own water bottles, filled at home, as no water fountain will be available
- All Participants and coaches will be allowed to enter the building 15 minutes prior to the start of your rental time
- Participants should exit the rink promptly after their program has concluded
- The entrance and exit doors will remain separate. Please make sure to use the correct doors
- There will be no use of locker rooms allowed, all players must come dressed and may use designated sitting areas prior to the start of your rental

### **Town of Greenwich Parks and Recreation—Anti-discrimination Policy**
