Subject: Tree Plantings at BTCC

We have planted on average about 50 trees per year for the 6 years I have been here. They range from Arborvitae for screening to specimen canopy trees. We planted 25 sugar Maples this past spring to replace about a dozen ash trees that were decimated from the emerald ash borer.

We have been planting bald cypress in our wetland areas when old forest growth dies or

uproots. They do very well on our property.

3 years ago, we planted about 60 coniferous trees to screen the neighbor's view of the tennis bubble.

We will continue to plant aesthetically pleasing trees to replace the rotted and decaying old forest growth that is predominantly swamp maples.
