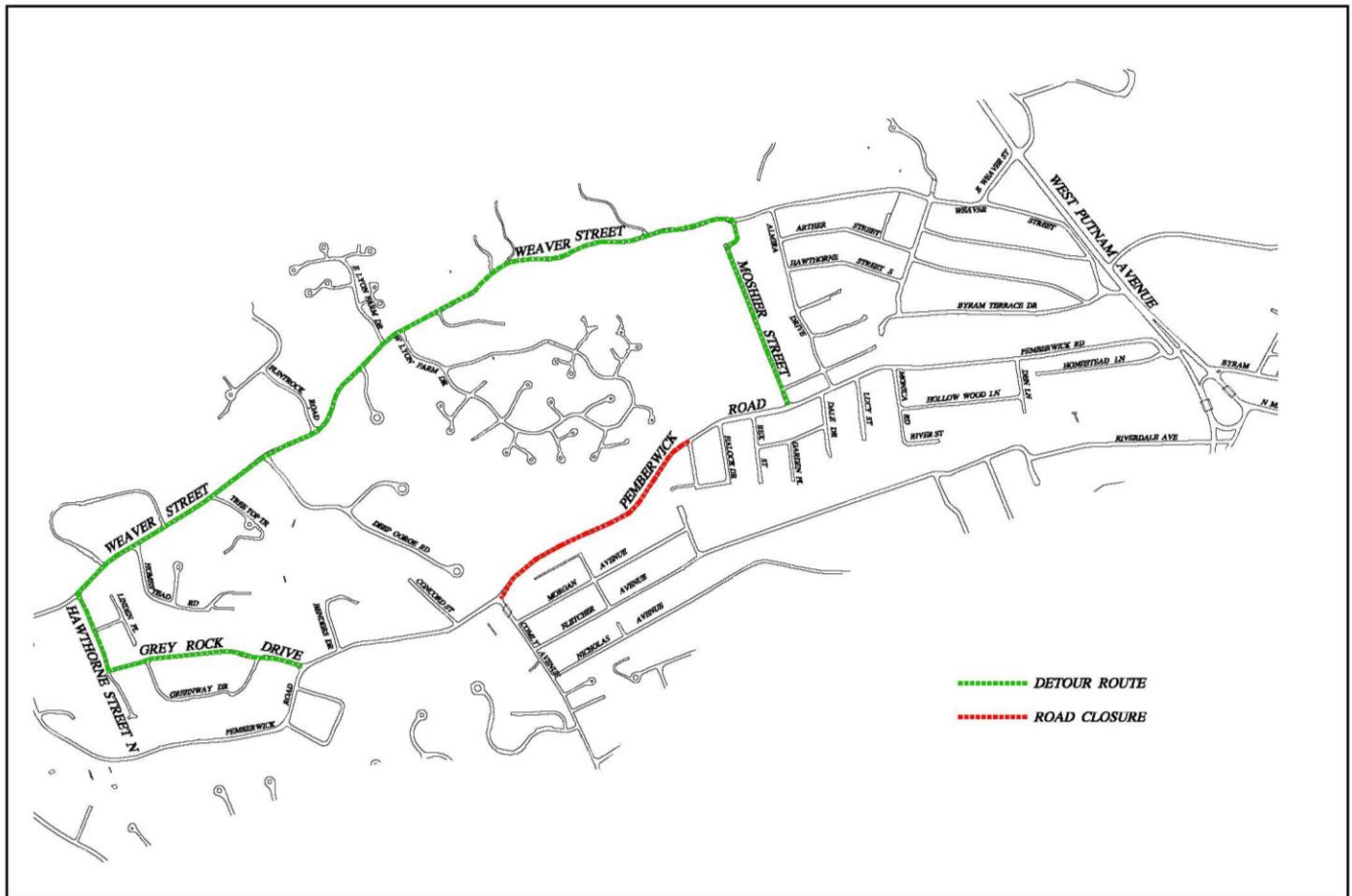

### **Pemberwick Road Closure Announcement**

**Greenwich, CT., June 25, 2021** – The Town of Greenwich, Department of Public Works, announced that starting Monday, June 28, a portion of Pemberwick Road (between Comly Avenue and Halock Drive) will be closed. Vehicles will be detoured using the following route: Moshier Street, Weaver Street, Hawthorne Street North, and Grey Rock Drive. Provided good weather for construction, Pemberwick Road is projected to reopen at the end of August.

Due to sections of a retaining wall supporting the southbound lane of Pemberwick Road in poor condition, this project consists of reconstructing two cast-in-place concrete retaining walls and installing new code compliant guide rails.
