

Call for Candidates to Serve on The Claims Committee of the RTM

The Appointments Committee requests that members of the RTM express their interest to serve on the Claims Committee (a Special Committee of the RTM as defined in section VI.B the [RTM Rules](#)). Candidates must be members of the RTM to serve.

Nine Regular Members and 2 Alternate Members are being sought for nomination to stand for appointment by the RTM at the April 2022 RTM Meeting.

The Role of the Claims Committee in the RTM

The power of the RTM to approve appropriation of the Board of Estimate and Taxation for the payment, compromise, or settlement upon recommendation of the Town Attorney of any claim against the town is delegated to the Claims Committee.

The chairman of the Claims Committee is the Moderator of the RTM.

The Committee meets as needed, usually in executive session, to discuss pending litigation. The term of the appointment is commensurate with that of the term of the current RTM and is subject to [§306 of the Town of Greenwich Municipal Code](#).

Skill sets critical to the healthy functioning of the Claims Committee include: Litigation, risk management, negotiation, general legal expertise, insurance expertise.

How to Express interest in Serving

The procedure for submitting nominations is as follows. Nominations are subject to section III.H.1-4 of the RTM Rules.

Candidates will please submit a CV to the secretary of the Appointments Committee at jude.collins@greenwichct.org to state their interest. These will be accepted until 12 noon on Friday January 28th. Interviews and nominations will take place thereafter.
