



Youth Scholarship Application

Greenwich Parks and Recreation is committed to making our youth activities accessible to all youth of Greenwich. To this end, the Department has established a youth scholarship program which provides financial assistance to qualifying residents.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Greenwich resident-proof of residency required
- Parent/legal guardian(s) of the child/children for which you are applying
- Household income at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
- Must have an established household account with Parks and Recreation

Required Documentation:

- Completed Youth Scholarship Application
- Proof of Residency (visit our website for residency information: www.greenwichct.gov/residency)
If your residency has been verified for the calendar year, no need to repeat this step.
- The most recent tax return to verify total household income for parent/guardian (s)
Alternatively, where applicable, the following may be submitted to verify income: Unemployment statement, SS income statement
- Additional information/documentation may be required.*

How to Apply for Scholarship:

- The preferred and most expeditious method of applying is via our website at: www.greenwichct.gov/youthscholarship
- Alternatively, you may submit the completed Youth Scholarship Application with required documentation to Parks and Recreation via email to: lcaserta@greenwichct.org, in person or via mail to: Greenwich Town Hall, Parks and Recreation-2nd Fl., 101 Field Point Road, Greenwich, CT 06830, Attn: Youth Scholarship
- Please note, incomplete applications will be returned.
- The scholarship year is January 1 - December 31 annually. A representative of the Department of Parks and Recreation may contact you to verify information. All information will be kept confidential.

Approval Process:

- Once the scholarship is approved, you will receive a scholarship award letter via email which will inform you of your funding status. You will be eligible for the approved % of fees for your dependent children for the remainder of the calendar year and can register for activities as registration opens online (www.greenwichct.gov/webtrac). It is strongly suggested that residents apply for scholarship consideration by January 15 to ensure approval prior to spring registration opening (February 1).
- Through the Scholarship Fund, each child will be eligible to participate in one activity/section per season with the exception of Summer Camp. Camp applications may be approved for greater than one section and will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Additional Information:

- Applicants may also be eligible for the necessary sports equipment for the activity in which they are applying, based on eligibility and available funds. Please contact our office at 203-622-6472 regarding equipment, a minimum of two weeks in advance of the activity start date.
- If for **any** reason, your child is unable to participate in the activity, please notify the Department in writing via email to lcaserta@greenwichct.org **prior** to the start of the activity in order to receive a refund/credit of your portion of fees.
