The following applies to the above referenced pool/spa in accordance with the 2015 IECC:

Section 403.10.1 - Pool / Spa Heaters

- The pool/spa heater[s] installed is ;are] equipped with a readily accessible on-off switch to allow shutting of the heater without sadjusting the thermostat setting.
- The pool/spa heaters[s] does[do] not have continuously burning pilot lights.
- There is no pool/spa heater installed with the pool equipment.

Section 403.10.2 - Time Switches

- Time switches that automatically turn off and on both heaters and pumps according to a pre-set schedule have been installed on all heaters and pumps.

- Public Health Standards require 24 hour pump operation.
- Pumps installed are required to operate solar and waste heat recovery pool heating system.

Section 403.10.3 - Pool / Spa Covers

- Pool / spa is equipped with a vapor-retardent pool / spa cover on or at the water surface.
