



Court Information and Rules

The Town of Greenwich OnePass with a Tennis/Pickleball Pass option is needed for tennis and pickleball play on all public park and school courts during the season. School courts are off limits when school is in session. OnePass, Tennis/Pickleball Pass, Tennis/Pickleball Guest Passes, and single use Tennis/Pickleball tickets may be purchased online at www.greenwichct.org/webtrac. Residency must be verified prior to purchase/renewal, once annually beginning in January.

RESERVATIONS:

- During the season, each Tennis/Pickleball Pass holder may reserve (1) hour of court time each day. They may play on open courts on a first-come, first-served basis, depending on court availability.
- Reservations may be made up to (5) days in advance. Please bring reservation receipt to the court.
- No group of players may reserve courts more than (2) hours in succession.
- Reservations will be held to the hour. Failure to arrive on time will result in a NO SHOW and the court time may be given to stand-by players.
- Tennis/Pickleball Pass holders who make reservations in their name must be present, or the reservation will not be honored. Remember, your OnePass and your Tennis/Pickleball Pass is NOT transferable.
- Open courts will be given one-hour at a time; if another group is waiting, players may not continue to play for the second hour.
- Tennis/Pickleball Pass holders may purchase a Tennis/Pickleball Guest Pass online. *The guest must be accompanied by the pass holder.*
- Programs run by the Department of Parks and Recreation and Greenwich Public Schools have priority. Reservations may not be available during scheduled programs and players may be asked to exit during program times.
- Passes must be presented to the court attendant for verification. Players without a Tennis/Pickleball Pass must pay for a single use Tennis/Pickleball ticket. This fee is non-refundable and cannot be applied toward the purchase of a pass.

GENERAL COURT RULES:

- Courts are for tennis and pickleball use only.
- Skateboards, bicycles, and scooters are prohibited at all times.
- No dogs allowed on the courts at any time.
- No food or beverages, other than water, are allowed on the courts. No glass containers.
- Private instruction is NOT permitted on town courts.
- Excessive noise, racquet throwing, and profanity are strictly prohibited.
- If the court(s) next to the players are in use, no more than 3 balls are allowed.
- Mobile pickleball nets can be carefully moved as needed. Tennis nets may not be removed.

It is the responsibility of all players to follow all rules and regulations. Any violations can be reported to the Tennis Clerk with names, dates, times, and witnesses. Any attendant on duty or Recreation Department staff member has the authority to enforce rules. Violation of any of these rules can result in the loss of court privileges.
