Mr. Muhlbaum's areas of practice include Elder Law (Medicaid planning, administrative fair hearings, incapacity planning), Estate Planning and Administration, and Probate matters including conservatorships.

Mr. Muhlbaum also serves as Chair of the Greenwich Board of Health.
