

**Scrap Metal** shall mean waste any material made of metal including ferrous (iron) metals and steel, stainless-steel, aluminum, tin, copper, bronze, or lead.

Greenwich considers any mixed material item that is 'in your estimation' made of 50% or more metal, to be a scrap metal item.

**RESTRICTIONS:**

- \* No 'out-of-town' metals. All metals delivered to the Holly Hill facility MUST have been generated within the Town of Greenwich.
- \* Out of Town businesses working for Greenwich residents or Greenwich businesses MUST have a signed and dated verification letter from the Greenwich resident or Greenwich business for each load delivered. See sample [Verification of Owner form](#).
- \* MUST NOT contain hazardous waste materials or wastes (to include compressed gasses, partially full fuel tanks, electronics, CFC containing items, fluorescent bulbs, batteries) upon disposal.
- \* The Holly Hill Facility will not accept more than twelve (12) cubic yards of material at a time from any one truck.
- \* Scavenging of metals is strictly prohibited at the Holly Hill Facility

**Where is scrap metal drop-off area?**

On the Operations Field, next to the Construction Debris area. The Operations Field is at the bottom of the hill, across from the Trash Transfer Building. Please pay first at the scale house.
