

**Batteries (Alkaline-household)** shall mean any long-lived dry cell with an alkaline electrolyte that decreases corrosion of the cell in order to store electrical energy for use in many consumer products.

**Batteries (Nickel-Cadmium/Nickel-Hydride/rechargeable)** shall mean any nickel-cadmium cell (commonly abbreviated NiCd or NiCad) using nickel oxide hydroxide and metallic cadmium as electrodes in order to store electrical energy. These are a type of rechargeable battery.

**RESTRICTIONS:**

- \* NO bags. ONLY LOOSE batteries are accepted!
- \* Separate alkaline batteries from Nickel-Cadmium/Nickel-Hydride/rechargeable batteries
- \* DO NOT bring batteries to Household Hazardous Waste Collection day.

**FEES:**

- \* \$0.00            There is no charge for batteries from residential/commercial sources.

**Where are the Alkaline Battery and Rechargeable Battery drop-off areas?**

In one of the well-marked blue Toter-style bins on the Operations Field, next to the attendant's shed. The Operations Field is at the bottom of the hill, across from the Trash Transfer Building.
