### LABORATORY BLOOD TESTING SERVICES

- Offered by the Greenwich Department of Health Laboratory, Town Hall, Lower Level, 101 Field Point Rd., 203-622-7843
- No appointment necessary
- Blood is drawn Monday – Friday, 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM
- Fee for service. (For specific fees, go to Laboratory fees.)

#### LEAD TESTING (finger stick method)

- This screening service is provided for children 1 to 6 years old. It is appropriate for families who feel their children may have been exposed to lead (e.g. living in an old house and/or one that has undergone renovation)
- Results are available immediately

#### CHOLESTEROL TEST (finger stick method)

- This test provides a full lipid profile: total cholesterol, HDL, LDL, and triglyceride level, as well as the ratio of total cholesterol to HDL.
- Fasting is required for this test
- Results are available immediately
