EXPLANATORY COMMENTS

Prior to the establishment of an historic district or districts, the Representative Town Meeting shall appoint or authorize the chief elected official to appoint an historic properties study committee for the purpose of making an investigation of one or more proposed historic district or districts. Each Committee established under the provision of this section shall consist of five regular and five alternate members who shall be electors of the municipality holding no salaried municipal office.

An already existing Historic District Commission may be appointed to make this investigation.

The Historic District Study Committee shall investigate and submit a report, which shall include the following:

- (1) An analysis of the historic significance and architectural merit of the buildings, structures, places or surroundings to be included in the proposed historic district or districts and the significance of the district as a whole.
- (2) A general description of the area to be included within the district or districts, including the total number of buildings in each such district or districts listed according to their known or estimated ages.
- (3) A map showing the exact boundaries of the area to be included within the district or districts.
- (4) A proposed ordinance or proposed ordinances designed to create and provide for the operation of an historic district or districts in accordance with the provisions of this part
- (5) Such other matters as the committee may deem necessary.

The Historic District Commission of the Town of Greenwich has agreed to serve as the Study Committee.
